May /meɪ/

EXAMPLE

She was born in **May**.

mermaid /'mɜːrmeɪd/

EXAMPLE

It's a story about a **mermaid**.

mile /maɪl/

EXAMPLE

He runs 10 **miles** every morning.

mouse /maʊs/

EXAMPLE

I prefer a wireless **mouse**.

mountain /'maʊntn/

EXAMPLE

We enjoy walking in the **mountains**.

much /mʌtʃ/

EXAMPLE

Thank you very **much** for the flowers.

music /'mju:zɪk/

EXAMPLE

He plays traditional Asian **music**.

amount /ə'maʊnt/

EXAMPLE

Mix the colors in equal **amounts**.**amazing** /ə'meɪzɪŋ/

EXAMPLE

I made an **amazing** discovery today.**small** /smɔ:l/

EXAMPLE

She comes from a **small** town.**lemon** /'lemən/

EXAMPLE

Add a few drops of **lemon** juice.**company** /'kʌmpəni/

EXAMPLE

She joined the **company** in 2009.**umbrella** /ʌm'brelə/

EXAMPLE

Where's my **umbrella**?**embark** /ɪm'ba:rk/

EXAMPLE

They were waiting to **embark**.

Where are you **from**?

name /neɪm/

EXAMPLE

What's her **name**?

room /ru:m/

EXAMPLE

He left the **room**.

rum /rʌm/

EXAMPLE

some /sʌm/

EXAMPLE

There's still **some** wine in the bottle.

time /taɪm/

EXAMPLE

What **time** is it?

I read about it in the **newspaper**.**nice** /naɪs/

EXAMPLE

EXAMPLE

Nobody knew what to say.**north** /nɔ:rθ/

EXAMPLE

The wind is coming from the **north**.**number** /'nʌmbər/

EXAMPLE

Think of a **number**.**nurse** /nɜ:rs/

EXAMPLE

She's a **nurse** at the local hospital.

EXAMPLE

We've got **ants** in our kitchen.**month** /mʌnθ/

EXAMPLE

The baby is three **months** old.**country** /ˈkʌntri/

EXAMPLE

What is the largest **country** in Europe?**lunch** /lʌntʃ/

EXAMPLE

What's for **lunch**?
