Affirmative phrases - simple present

- 1. I am from Brazil. (Eu sou do Brasil.)
- 2. My mother is Canadian. (Minha mãe é canadense.)
- 3. My husband is not fat. He is thin. (Meu marido não é gordo. Ele é magro.)
- 4. Rio de Janeiro is my favorite city. (Rio de Janeiro é minha cidade favorita.)
- 5. That is my favorite color. (Aquele é a minha cor favorita.)
- 6. Blue and Red are my favorite colors. (Azul e vermelho são minhas cores favoritas.)
- 7. I am so happy to be here with you. (Eu estou tão feliz de estar aqui com vocês.)
- 8. You are so kind. (Você é tão gentil.)
- 9. All we need is respect. (Tudo o que nós precisamos é de respeito.)

Interrogative phrases - simple present

- 1. Where are you from? (De onde você é?)
- 2. Who are you? (Quem é você?)
- 3. Whose books are those? (De quem são aqueles livros?)
- 4. What is your name? (Qual é o seu nome?)
- 5. Why are you here? (Por que você está aqui?)
- 6. How is your brother? (Como está o seu irmão?)
- 7. How are you doing? (Como vai você?)
- 8. How much is this wallet? (Quanto custa essa carteira?)
- 9. How old are you? (Quantos anos você tem?)
- 10. Are you ok? (Você está bem?)

Talking about weather

- 1. It's raining a lot today. (está chovendo muito hoje.)
- 2. It's very hot in here. (Está muito quente aqui.)
- 3. It's so cloudy outside. (Está tão nublado lá fora.)
- 4. It is going to rain tonight. (Vai chover hoje a noite.)
- 5. It's snowing again! (Está nevando novamente.)
- 6. It is so windy today. (Está ventando tanto hoje)

Demonstrating this/these - that/those

- 1. That girl over there is my sister. (Aquele garota lá é minha irmã.)
- 2. This is your book. (Este é o seu livro.)

Negative phrases - simple present

- 4. My mother doesn't speak english. (Minha mãe não fala inglês.)
- 5. We do not work on Saturdays. (Nós não trabalhamos nos sábados.)
- 6. They're not in school this week. (Eles/Elas não estão na escola essa semana.)
- 7. I never work on Sundays. (Eu nunca trabalho nos domingos.)
- 8. She doesn't look like her mom. (Ela não parece com a mãe dela.)
- 9. Excuse me, this soup isn't hot. (Com licença, essa sopa não está quente.)
- 10. My cat never leaves the house (Meu gato nunca sai de casa.)

Future phrases - simple future/future continuous

- 1. I will stay home today, I am kind of sick. (Vou ficar em casa hoje, estou meio doente.)
- 2. I'm going to help you. (Eu vou te ajudar.)
- 3. We're going to buy that book, everybody is talking about it. (Nós vamos comprar aquele livro, todo mundo está falando sobre ele.)
- 4. The boy will visit her mother in Japan in the end of the year. (O garoto irá visitar sua mãe no Japão no fim do ano.)
- 5. We won't miss school tomorrow. (Nós não vamos faltar na escola amanhã.)
