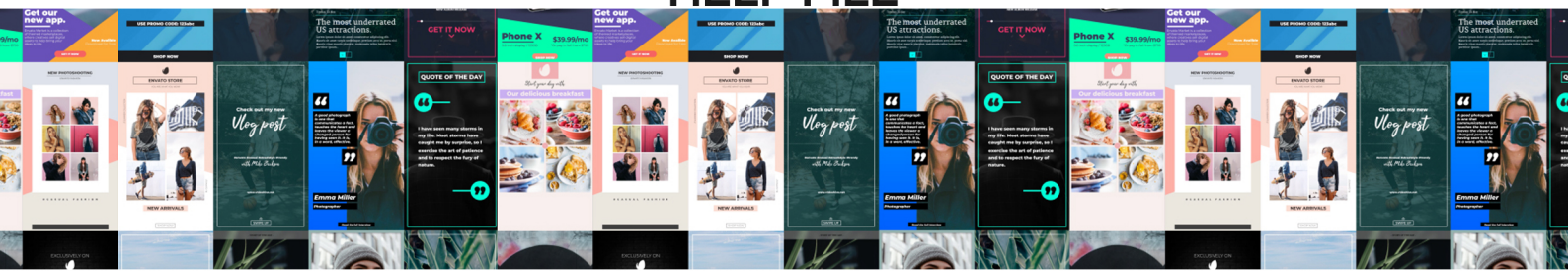


# HELP FILE



Thank you for purchasing this template. I'm happy you liked it.

This documentation file includes everything you need to know in order to customize your project and get started.

## 1. Add your footages and texts

Once you opened the project, go to File -> Import -> File and import your footage in the project. In the left side you see a folder named **Assets**. In "Assets folder" you have the "Stories Compositions folder". Every story has its own folder. Once you choose the story you want to use open the Story\_XX Folder. In that folder you'll see a Story\_XX Comp and the "Compositions to edit folder". In that folder you'll see the compositions you have to edit. So to change the footage just open the Footage\_XX Composition and drag & drop your footage to it. To edit the text just open the Texts Composition and by double-clicking it you easily modify the texts. **!! NOTE !! - Story\_01 & Story\_24 have products. So be sure the products you want to use are with transparent background.**

## 2. Add your logo

Import your logo by clicking File -> Import -> File. After you imported your logo in the project, in the "Assets Folder" you see a folder named "02. Change Your Logo". In that folder you have the "PUT YOUR LOGO HERE COMPOSITION". So all you have to do is to open that composition and just drag and drop your logo.

## 3. Change the colors

In the "Assets folder" we also have a folder called "03. Stories Composition" which contains all the stories. Open the folder of the story you want to use and you'll see the composition named with the name of each story. After you open that story comp you'll see a "Color Control Layer" which allows you easily change all the colors of the scene. **!! NOTE !! - In the "COLOR CONTROL LAYER" you'll see also the logo color controller. If the "Color Control Overlay ON/OFF" is checked you can choose a color to fill your logo with the color "Logo Color" controller otherwise if you want to use your original logo colors simply uncheck the checkbox.**

## 4. Render the File

Once you have set up your project, open All Stories 1080p Composition and go to "Composition -> Add to Render Queue" set your settings and hit render.
