1 - **OUT OF**

EXAMPLE

```
Let's get out of here.
[outtof] ou [outta]
EXAMPLE
I am out of money.
[outtof] ou [outta]
EXAMPLE
Stay out of trouble.
[outtof] ou [outta]
EXAMPLE
Keep them out of here.
[outtof] ou [outta]
EXAMPLE
You need to get it out of the way.
[outtof] ou [outta]
EXAMPLE
I am out of breath.

2 - GOING TO

EXAMPLE

What are you **going to** do?

[gonna]

EXAMPLE

I am **going to** go home.

[gonna]

EXAMPLE

I am **going to** study more tonight.

[gonna]

EXAMPLE

You are **going to** like this movie.

[gonna]

EXAMPLE

You are **going to** miss your train!

[gonna]

EXAMPLE

I was **going to** tell him but I forgot.

[gonna]

3 - **A LOT OF**

EXAMPLE

She has got **a lot of** money.

[alotof] ou [alotta]



EXAMPLE

A lot of people went to the game.

[alotof] ou [alotta]

EXAMPLE

There is a lot of milk in the bucket.

[alotof] ou [alotta]

EXAMPLE

They have **a lot of** problems to solve.

[alotof] ou [alotta]

4 - WANT TO

EXAMPLE

They don't **want to** play with us.

[wanna]

EXAMPLE

I don't **want to** hear that.

[wanna]

EXAMPLE

I want to eat pizza for lunch.

[wanna]

EXAMPLE

What do you want to do?

[wanna]

EXAMPLE

Do you want to talk to me?

[wanna]



EXAMPLE

We don't **want to** live here anymore.

[wanna]

5 - WANTS TO

EXAMPLE

She wants to talk to you.

[wansta]

EXAMPLE

He wants to go home.

[wansta]

EXAMPLE

He wants to do the right thing.

[wansta]

EXAMPLE

I don't think she **wants to** go.

[wansta]

EXAMPLE

Do you think he **wants to** go swimming?

[wansta]
