1 - Rewrite the sentences using the paired conjunction given in brackets:

c) Harry used to smoke cigarette. Helen used to smoke cigarette. (either...or).

d) We should learn to accept our weaknesses and our strengths. (not only...but also).

e) He never listens to or advises his friends when they have a problem. (neither...nor).

f) I've betrayed your trust. I've betrayed your love for me. (not only...but also).

g) Armand is more than sad, he is unhappy. (not...but).

h) He felt disappointed. He felt misunderstood. (both...and).

i) Rachel should apologize or leave. (either...or).

j) Richard and John didn't keep her secret. (neither...nor).

k) Ryan came to my birthday party. Sue came to my birthday party. (both...and).
