KIND OF - KINDA

EXAMPLE

She is kind of cute.

She's kinda cute.

EXAMPLE

Are you kind of mad at me?

Are you kinda mad at me?

EXAMPLE

She kind of smiled at me.

She kinda smiled at me.

EXAMPLE

That is kind of funny.

That's kinda funny.

SORT OF - SORTA

EXAMPLE

I am still **sort of** sad that school is over.

I'm still sorta sad that school is over.

EXAMPLE

My new dress is **sort of** green.

My new dress is sorta green.



He said it **sort of** nervously.

He said it **sorta** nervously.

EXAMPLE

She's spent the whole year **sort of** traveling around the world.

She's spent the whole year sorta traveling around the world.

LET ME - LEMME

EXAMPLE

Let me ask you something.

Lemme ask you something.

EXAMPLE

Let me know if you need anything.

Lemme know if you need anything.

EXAMPLE

He didn't let me see it.

He didn't lemme see it.

EXAMPLE

Let me go!

Lemme go!

GOT TO - GOTTA

EXAMPLE

I got to go now.

I gotta go now.



You got to be careful.

You gotta be careful.

EXAMPLE

We got to keep practicing.

We gotta keep practicing.

EXAMPLE

You got to be kidding.

You gotta be kidding.

LOTS OF - LOTSA

EXAMPLE

He has got **lots of** money.

He's got lotsa money.

EXAMPLE

Lots of people don't know that.

Lotsa people don't know that.

EXAMPLE

Just expect **lots of** traffic, especially on the ferry route.

Just expect lotsa traffic, especially on the ferry route.

EXAMPLE

I wish them **lots of** luck.

I wish them lotsa luck.



GIVE ME - GIMME

EXAMPLE

Give me that.

Gimme me that.

EXAMPLE

Can you give me a hand?

Can you **gimme** a hand?

EXAMPLE

You give me no choice.

You **gimme** no choice.

EXAMPLE

If you need anything, just give me a call.

If you need anything, just gimme a call.

SHOULD HAVE - SHOULDA

EXAMPLE

I **should have** called him.

I shoulda called him.

EXAMPLE

I **should have** been there.

I **shoulda** been there.

EXAMPLE

I **should have** seen it coming.

I shoulda seen it coming.



We **should have** gone away.

We **shoulda** gone away.

COULD HAVE - COULDA

EXAMPLE

You could have been hurt!

You coulda been hurt!

EXAMPLE

We **could have** tried harder.

We coulda tried harder.

EXAMPLE

He could have spoken to her.

He coulda spoken to her.

EXAMPLE

We **could have** told him.

We coulda told him.

WOULD HAVE - WOULDA

EXAMPLE

She would have known that.

She woulda known that.

EXAMPLE

I would have been there.

I woulda been there.



I would have thought so.

I woulda thought so.

EXAMPLE

They would have done the right thing.

They woulda done the right thing.
