



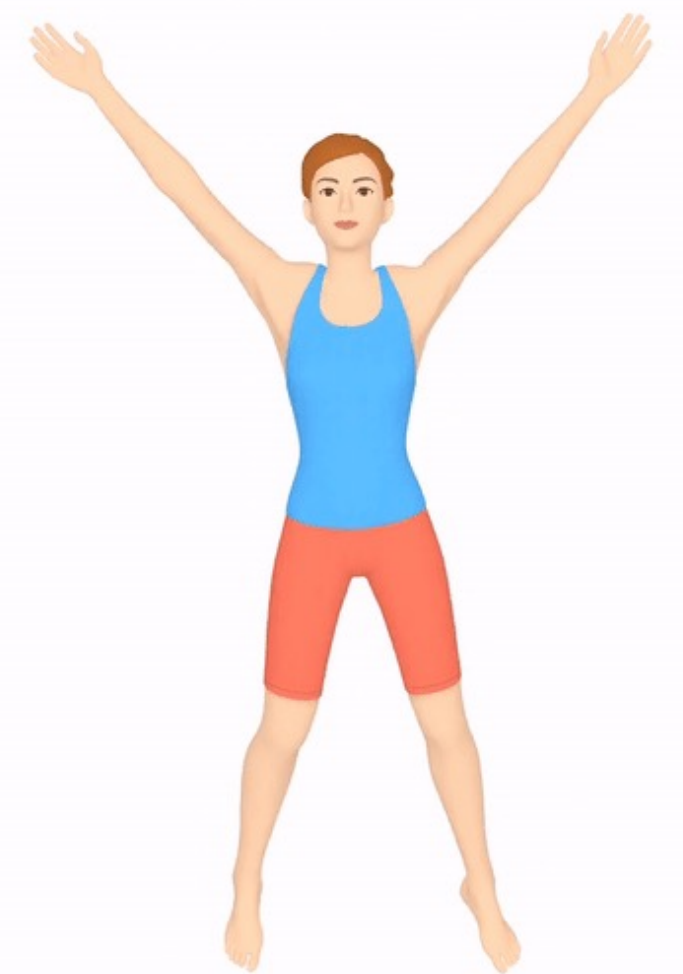

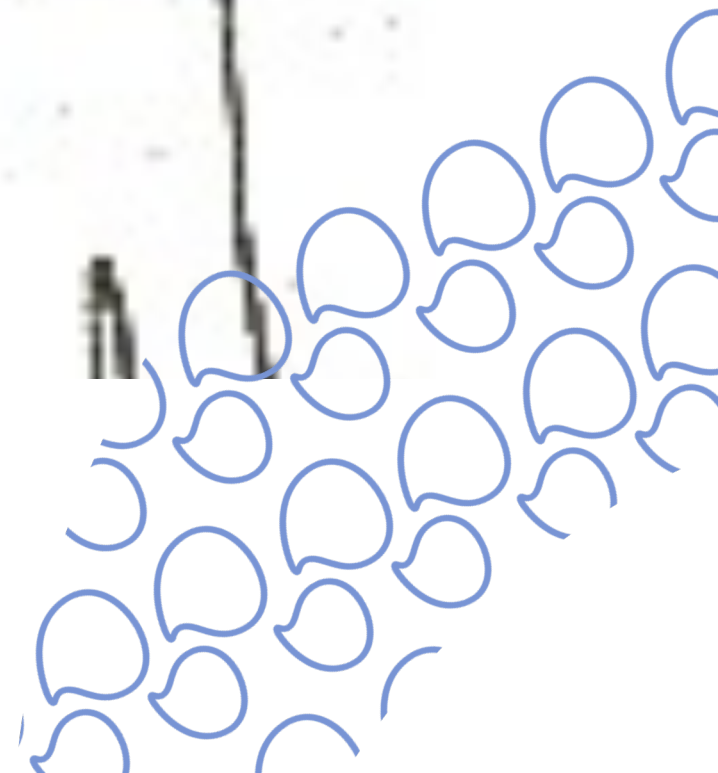
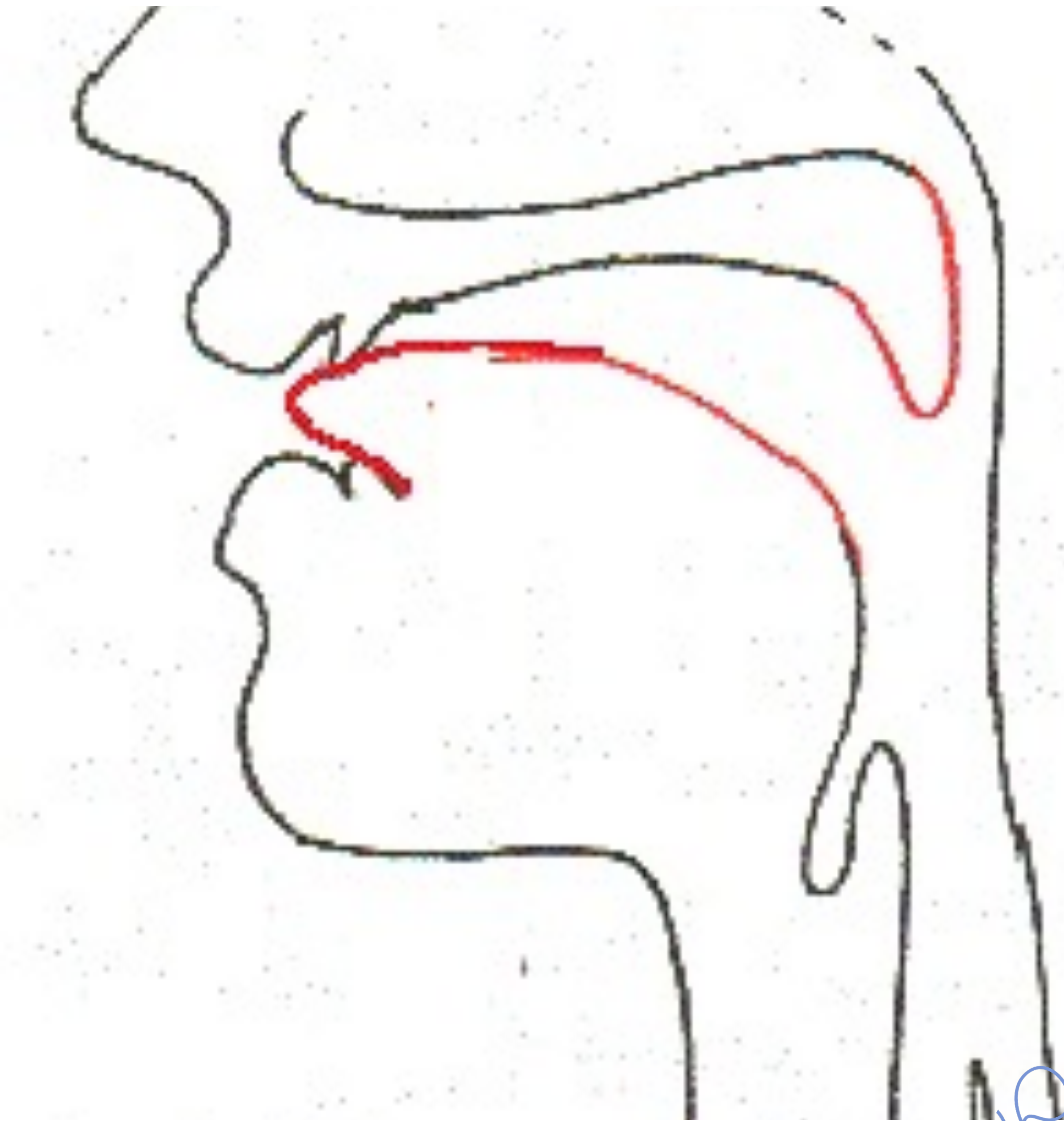

1. Ponta da língua entre os dentes
2. Fora da boca!
3. Fluxo de ar constante e suave
4. Língua relaxada



Unvoiced & Voiced TH

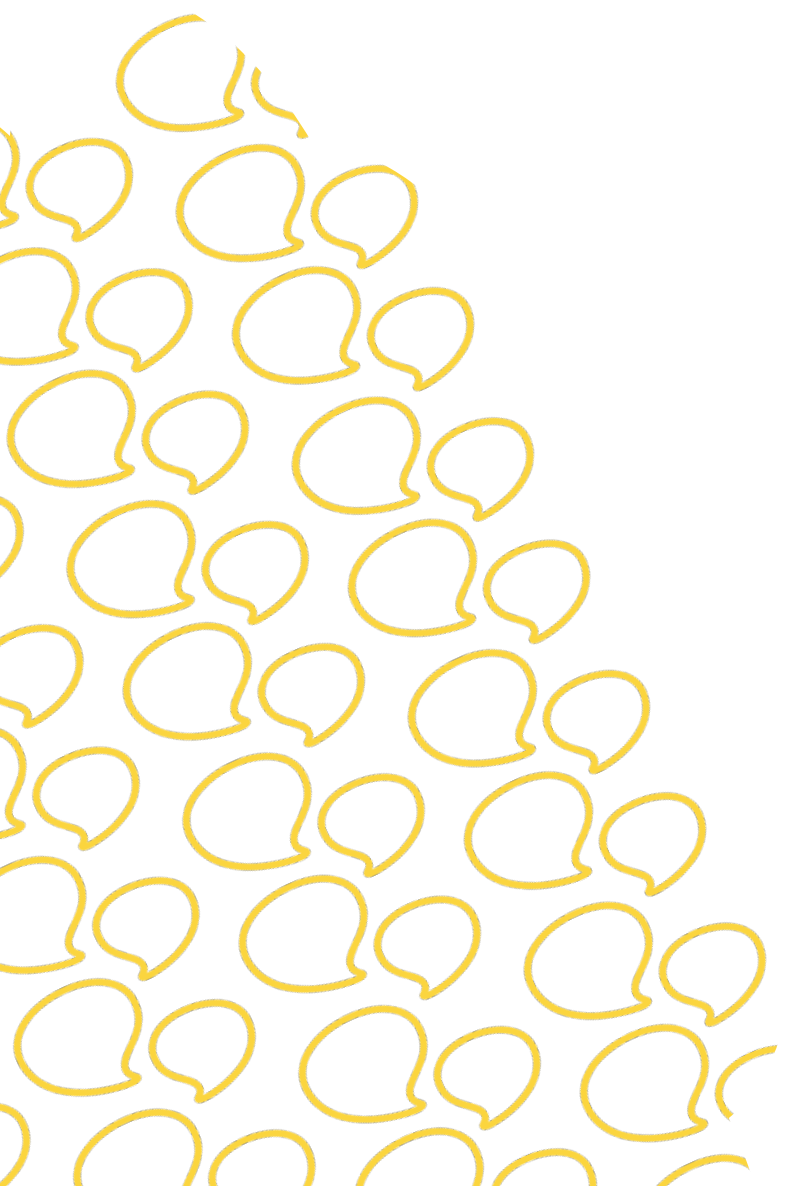


- Unvoiced TH → vocal fold are off
- Voiced TH → vocal folds are on

Common Mistakes



- Não colocar a língua pra fora
- Não manter um fluxo suave de ar
- Encostar o lábio inferior nos dentes superiores
