### Comprehension Questions:

**Answer each question in a complete sentence**

1. Why did Kelly slam (on) her brakes while driving to work?
2. Why didn't the driver of the carriage help put out the fire?
3. Who did Kelly call for help, and how did the woman on the phone react?
4. Who was the hero of this story and why?
5. What does the word "commute" mean?
6. How do you commute to work every day?

### Answers to comprehension questions:

1. Kelly slammed (on) her brakes because there was a horse pulling a carriage, that was on fire, crossing the street in front of her.
2. The driver was unconscious. He probably had passed out from smoke inhalation.
3. Kelly called the fire department, and the woman on the phone thought she was kidding. She responded by saying, "Come on! You've got to be kidding me!"
4. The horse was the hero because he backed the carriage up into the water and put out the fire.
5. The word commute can be a verb or a noun. As a verb it means to travel from home to work and vice versa. As a noun it means the journey between your house and your work place and vice versa.
6. Answers vary. Ex: I commute to work by bus/car/train/etc.
