almost / 'a:lmaʊst/

EXAMPLE

I almost forgot your birthday.

although /ɔːlˈðəʊ/

EXAMPLE

Although small, the kitchen is well designed.

already /ɔːlˈredi/

EXAMPLE

I'm already late.

awe /ɔː/

EXAMPLE

I stared at the clouds, in **awe** of their beauty.

law /loː/

EXAMPLE

The reforms have recently become law.

saw /soː/

EXAMPLE

I saw him last week.

call /kɔːl/

EXAMPLE

We usually **call** him by his nickname.

small /smoxl/

EXAMPLE

The world seems so small now.



ball /bo:l/

EXAMPLE

He kicked the ball into the net.

talk /taːk/

EXAMPLE

I can't **talk** about it just now.

walk/wo:k/

EXAMPLE

I always walk to school.

chalk /tsik/

EXAMPLE

He picked up a piece of **chalk** and wrote the answer on the blackboard.

lawyer / 'loɪər/

EXAMPLE

You would be wise to consult a lawyer.

false /fo:ls/

EXAMPLE

He used a **false** name to get the job.

always / 'ɔːlweɪz/

EXAMPLE

She always arrives at 7.30.

August /ɔːˈgʌst/

EXAMPLE

They got married last August.

water / wo:tər/

EXAMPLE

They survived for two days without food or water.



author / 'ɔːθər/

EXAMPLE

Who is your favourite author?

abroad /ə broːd/

EXAMPLE

He worked **abroad** for a year.

boss /boss/

EXAMPLE

I'll ask my **boss** if I can have the day off.

login / lo:gɪn/

EXAMPLE

Enter your login and password and press 'go'.

thought /0>:t/

EXAMPLE

Such a **thought** never entered my head.

caught /kɔːt/

EXAMPLE

She threw the bottle into the air and **caught** it again.

bought /bo:t/

EXAMPLE

I just **bought** a new car.

taught /to:t/

EXAMPLE

They taught him to read.

daughter / do:tər/

EXAMPLE

We have two sons and a daughter.



wrong /ro:n/

EXAMPLE

I got all the answers wrong.

song /so:ŋ/

EXAMPLE

We sang a **song** together.

long /loːŋ/

EXAMPLE

She had long dark hair.

gone /goːn/

EXAMPLE

'Where's the coffee?' 'It's all gone.'

more /mzr/

EXAMPLE

There is room for no **more** than three cars.

door /do:r/

EXAMPLE

Open the door!

floor /flo:r/

EXAMPLE

His glass fell to the **floor** and broke.

war /wɔːr/

EXAMPLE

My grandfather fought in the war.

four /foir/

EXAMPLE

Look at page four.



north /norθ/

Which way is **north**?
