Sentences for Anki | Lesson 11

FRONT

After they had been playing at the creek for 3 hours, the boys realized they needed to get back home for dinner before their mother was angry.

BACK

Depois de eles terem brincado no riacho por 3 horas, os garotos perceberam que eles precisavam voltar para casa para o jantar antes que sua mãe ficasse brava.

get back = to return to a person, place, or condition.

You can imagine that the mother of these boys has been working on dinner and expects them to be home in time to eat. They have already been playing for 3 hours at the creek, and realize they need to return home, or get back home.

FRONT

Sara called to see if she could get back that coat that she let you borrow.

RACK

Sara ligou para ver se ela poderia <u>pegar de volta</u> aquele casaco que ela deixou você pegar emprestado.

get back = to return to a person, place, or condition.

Sara owned a coat that she let a friend borrow for a while. Now she would like to get back the coat or have it in her possession again so that she can wear it. It was hers, then she gave it someone, now she wants to get it back.

FRONT

The house needs to get back into a clean state before dad gets home!

BACK

A casa precisa <u>voltar</u> a um estado de limpeza antes que o papai chegue em casa! **get back** = to return to a person, place, or condition.

In this case, you can tell that the children have probably made the house dirty or messy while their dad is gone. They need to get it back in order, or return it to its clean condition, before their dad gets home.

FRONT

Mrs. Francis gets back from her business trip on Thursday.

BACK

Mrs. Francis volta de sua viagem de negócios na quinta-feira.

get back = to return to a person, place, or condition.

Mrs. Francis was traveling away from home on a business. She is coming home to her own house on Thursday. She gets back on Thursday.

FRONT

Jamie played a trick on Eric in front of his friends and now Eric want to get back at him.

BACK

Jamie pregou uma peça em Eric na frente de seus amigos e agora Eric quer <u>se vingar</u> dele.

get back = to seek revenge on someone for a wrong-doing.

When Jamie played a trick, he likely embarrassed Eric. Now Eric is mad and he wants to get revenge, or get back, at Jamie. Eric might try to play a trick on Jamie to embarrass him.

FRONT

When it started raining hard, the bikers realized they needed to <u>get back</u> to the parking lot as soon as possible.

BACK

Quando começou a chover forte, os motoqueiros perceberam que eles precisavam voltar ao estacionamento o mais rápido possível.

get back = to return to a person, place, or condition.

The bikers were probably on a trail biking, but then it started raining hard. They realized they need to return to the parking lot and get in their cars as soon as possible. They need to get back, or return to the parking lot.

FRONT

Justine wanted to paint her old bookshelf a darker brown so she could get it back to it's original beauty.

BACK

Justine queria pintar sua velha prateleira com um marrom mais escuro, assim ela conseguiria <u>recuperar</u> a sua beleza original.

get back = to return to a person, place, or condition.

The bookshelf is old, and probably has lots of scratches and chipped paint on it. Justine knows that it used to be a beautiful bookshelf. She is going to paint it so that the bookshelf will be beautiful again. It will get back to its beautiful condition.

When the fire started to spread, the firefighter yelled, "Get back!"

BACK

Quando o primeiro incêndio começou a se espalhar, o bombeiro gritou, "Volta!"

get back = to return to a place, or move back to a place

If there is something imminently dangerous, like a fire or explosion, someone might yell, "Get back." They are warning you to move backwards, or move away from the danger. Get back from the danger.

FRONT

After they lost their map of the woods, the group of kids knew they wouldn't be able to get back to their secret spot.

BACK

Depois de terem perdido seu mapa da floresta, o grupo de crianças sabia que eles não conseguiriam <u>voltar</u> ao seu lugar secreto.

get back = to return to a person, place, or condition.

These kids were wandering in the woods looks for a secret spot they had probably found earlier. They lost their map and couldn't find the spot. They knew they wouldn't be able to return to the spot or get back to the spot.

FRONT

Gregory wanted to get his bike back from his friend Jim, who had been "borrowing" it for 2 months.

BACK

Gregory queria <u>pegar sua bicicleta de volta</u> de seu amigo Jim, que tinha "pegado ela emprestado" por 2 meses.

get back = to return to a person, place, or condition.

Gregory let his friend Jim borrow his bike, but Jim had been borrowing it for two months. This was too long for Gregory and he wanted his bike again. He wanted to get it back from Jim.

The store was closed when I went after work, so I will have to go back tomorrow during lunch.

BACK

A loja tinha fechado quando eu fui *(lá)* depois do trabalho, então eu terei que <u>voltar</u> amanhã durante o almoço.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

In this case, someone tried to a store, but the store was already closed. They will have to return tomorrow, or go back tomorrow, when the store is open.

FRONT

Hank forgot what happened in Chapter 2, so he had to go back and re-read the entire chapter.

BACK

Hank esqueceu o que tinha acontecido no capítulo 2, então ele teve que <u>voltar</u> e reler o capítulo inteiro.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

While reading, Hank wanted to remember something that happened previously in the story, but he couldn't remember. He had to go back, or return to Chapter 2, so that he could read the chapter again.

FRONT

Lily missed her family and was glad that she was going to be able to <u>go back</u> home over Christmas Break.

BACK

Lily sentiu saudades de sua família e estava feliz que ela ia conseguir <u>voltar</u> para casa no feriado de Natal.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

Lily has probably been away from her family, either at college or a job in a different city. She will return to her hometown to see her family. She has been away but now she will go back home.

FRONT

Go back inside and get your coat before you leave for school!

BACK

Volte para dentro e pegue seu casaco antes que você saia para a escola!

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

In this case, it is likely that a child has come out of the house to go to school without a coat on. The parent knows that the weather is cold, or rainy, and wants the child to have a coat. The child is asked to return, or go back, to the house to get their coat.

FRONT

Kathy will have to go back to the grocery store to get the last few ingredients in order to make the cake.

BACK

Kathy terá que <u>voltar</u> à mercearia para comprar os últimos poucos ingredientes para fazer o bolo.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

Since she has to go back, or return, to the store, it seems Kathy has already been to the store once. She went to the store, came home, and then realized she needed more ingredient. Kathy will have to go back to the store.

FRONT

After James and Monica got in a fight, she knew that things would never go back to how they used to be.

BACK

Depois que James e Monica começaram uma briga, ela sabia que as coisas nunca iriam voltar a como costumavam ser.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

James and Monica were in a relationship - either a friendship or otherwise. When they got in a fight, Monica knew that it was going to be bad for their relationship. She knew it would be hard to return, or go back, to how their relationship used to be.

FRONT

The doctor said that Haley can't <u>go back</u> to school until her temperature is down and she has taken the medicine for 3 days.

BACK

O médico disse que Haley não pode <u>voltar</u> para a escola até que sua temperatura diminua e ela tenha tomado o remédio por 3 dias.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

In this case, Haley has been sick. She has a temperature and has been to the doctor because she's not feeling well. The doctor suggested that she not go back, or return to school until she feels better.

The ice cream was so good that Sheri wanted to go back the next night to get more.

BACK

O sorvete estava tão bom que Sheri queria voltar na noite seguinte para comprar mais.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

Sheri visited an ice cream shop that was very tasty. She liked it so much that she went one night, and then wanted to return, or go back, the next night for more!

FRONT

When Jesse tried on the jacket, he knew he would need to go back to the store and get a different size.

BACK

Quando Jesse experimentou a jaqueta, ele soube que precisaria <u>voltar</u> à loja e comprar um tamanho diferente.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

Jesse has bought a jacket, but we can see that the jacket does not fit. He will need a different size. He will have to return to the store, or go back to the store.

FRONT

Mrs. James asked Samantha to <u>go back</u> and check over her work for any mistakes she might have made.

BACK

A Sra. James pediu para Samantha voltar e verificar seu trabalho por qualquer erro que ela poderia ter feito.

go back = to return to a place, time or condition

Mrs. James is looking at Samantha's work that she has completed. She asks Samantha to take a second look at her work, or go back and look at her work again.

FRONT

Once I heard the first verse, the song started to <u>come back</u> to me as I sang the chorus loudly.

BACK

Assim que eu ouvi o primeiro verso, a música começou a <u>voltar à minha memória</u> enquanto eu cantava o refrão em voz alta.

come back = to return, especially to one's memory

In this case, the song is triggering a memory. The person is trying to remember the song, and once they hear the verse, the melody of the song comes back to their memory, or the memory returns to them.

FRONT

When you have finished at the grocery store, come back to pick me up at the mall.

BACK

Quando você tiver terminado na mercearia, volte para me pegar no shopping.

come back = to return to a former position or state

If you have dropped someone off, in this case at the mall, they may asked you to pick them up. In this case, someone is going to the store, then will return, or come back to the mall.

FRONT

The little boy always had an attitude and would <u>come back</u> at his teacher with rude comments.

BACK

O garotinho sempre teve uma personalidade forte e <u>voltava</u> para o seu professor com comentários rudes.

come back = to talk back or retort

Come back is a sassy way of speaking. Often it is a retort, or a way to show attitude towards someone. In this case, the little boy has an attitude towards his teacher, and comes back, or retorts, with a rude comment.

FRONT

Owen opened up the photo album and all the stories from his childhood in Chile started to <u>come back to him</u>.

BACK

Owen abriu o álbum de fotos e todas as histórias de sua infância no Chile começaram a voltar à sua memória.

come back = to return, especially to one's memory

Photos can often cause you to remember certain stories or have strong memories. Owen begins remembering the stories from his childhood in Chile when he looks at the photos. The memories come back to him, or return to him.

FRONT

Jacob and Melanie will travel in Europe for 3 months, and then <u>come back</u> home to California in time for school to start.

BACK

Jacob e Melanie viajarão na Europa por 3 meses e depois <u>voltarão</u> para casa na Califórnia a tempo para o começo das aulas.

come back = to return to a former position or state

Jacob and Melanie live in California but are leaving to travel in Europe. They will be gone from California for 3 months, and then will return, or come back home.

Once it started pouring rain, Leslie needed to <u>come back</u> to her tent and try to call for help before her phone was soaked!

BACK

Assim que começou a pingar chuva, Leslie precisou <u>voltar</u> para sua barraca para tentar ligar por ajudar antes que seu telefone ficasse ensopado.

come back = to return to a former position or state

Leslie is camping and staying in a tent. She was likely out hiking, but once it started raining, needed to return, or come back to the tent to call for help.

FRONT

When Mrs. Wong told Jimmy he wasn't going to get dessert, he came back at her and said, "I don't want dessert anyways!"

BACK

Quando a Sra. Wong disse ao Jimmy que ele não iria comer sobremesa, <u>ele respondeu</u> para ela "Eu não guero sobremesa mesmo!"

come back = to talk back or retort

Jimmy was likely mad that his mother wouldn't let him have dessert because of a punishment. Because he was mad, he had an attitude towards his mom, and wanted to make her mad as well. He came back at her with a rude comment.

FRONT

Even if I haven't ridden a bike in years, the skill always <u>comes back to me</u> after a few minutes of riding.

BACK

Mesmo que eu não tenha andado de bicicleta por anos, a habilidade sempre <u>volta à minha memória</u> depois de alguns minutos pedalando.

come back = to return, especially to one's memory

They always say that once you learn how to ride a back, you will always remember. Once you start to ride again, even if it's been a long time, the skill of riding always returns, or comes back to you.

FRONT

After summer break, all the students <u>come back</u> with stories of the things they did throughout June and July.

BACK

Depois do fim das férias de verão, todos os alunos <u>voltam</u> com histórias das coisas que eles fizeram durante junho e julho.

come back = to return to a former position or state

Students go to school in the fall and spring, but are out of school in the summer. They leave school in the spring, sometimes go on adventures, and then come back, or return to school in the fall and share stories of their summer break.

FRONT

When Kayla's grandmother makes homemade Key Lime Pie, memories of her childhood come back to her mind.

Back

Quando a avó de Kayla faz torta de limão caseira, memórias de sua infância <u>voltam à sua memória</u>.

come back = to return, especially to one's memory

Sometimes food reminds people of childhood memories - recipes that your mother or grandmother used to make. In this case, Kayla has strong memories of her childhood that are triggered by her grandmother's Key Lime Pie. The memories return, or come back to her.
